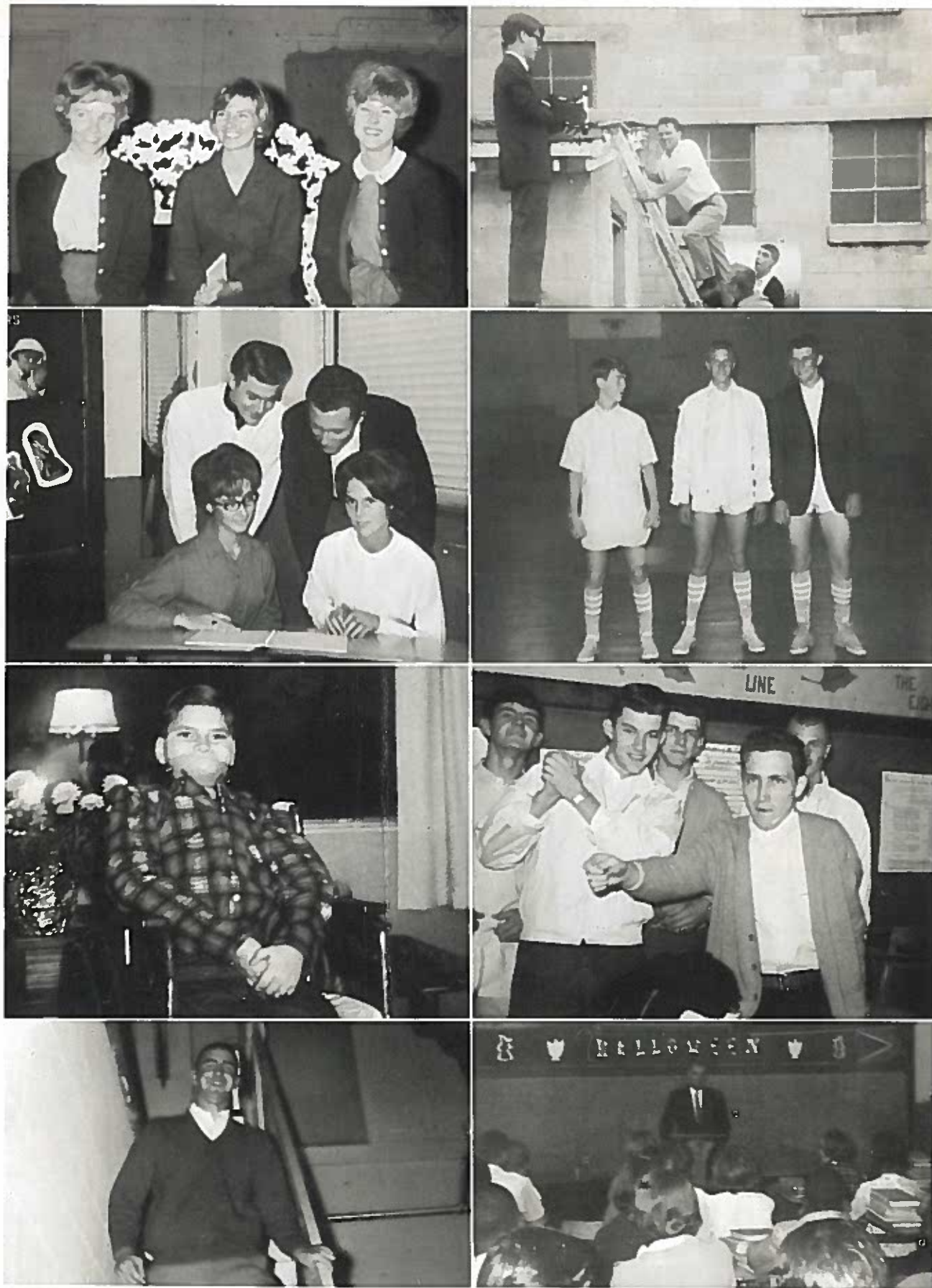
## Classes . . .
